Siyyum Bekhorim **Friday, March 30 following** **6:45 a.m. Shaharit services**

The Fast of The Firstborn (Ta'anit Bekhorim) reminds us that when the first-born of Egypt were slain during the tenth plague, the Israelite first-born were spared. In appreciation of this, all first-born Jews should fast on Erev Pesah. However, this responsibility is nullified when the individual joins in a festive meal marking the completion (siyyum) of the study of a Jewish text. Each year we arrange for a siyyum on Erev Pesah so that first-born need not fast that day.

This year, Erev Pesah falls on Friday, March 30. That morning, services will begin at 6:45 a.m. and will be followed by our siyyum and (a hametzdik) breakfast. We hope you will join us.
